# Introduction

The 1459 letters of Cons 488/30 provide a valuable insight to aspects of Fitzgerald's administration. Evident are his concern for the development of infrastructure, especially roads and bridges, the development of rural towns with convict aid and the commencement of mounted police, among other matters. Some of the difficulties he encountered can be appreciated as well as his humanity in convict affairs.

## How to Use the Index

Both the pages of the letter book and the letters are numbered. The page numbers range from 1—459, with an additional page A212. The letters are in date order but are numbered erratically:

The Theme-topic Index contains a section entitled "Administration: general". This heading lists those letters of which the import is unclear, generally because reference is made to other correspondence not within Cons 488/30.
