Introduction

The 1553 letters of Cons 488/31 show the development of Fitzgerald's administration. The early development of the Port Gregory area, together with the maintenance and expansion of older settlements intersperse with an increasing need for regulations and staff difficulties.

How to Use the Index

Both the pages of the letter book and the letters are numbered. The page numbers range from 1–378, with two additional pages, 168a and 355a. The pages are not numbered after 378, although continuing until 455, and these un-numbered pages and are shown in the Index in italics. The letters are in date order but are numbered erratically:

Any general consideration of transported persons needs examine both headings, Convicts and Ticket of Leave.

The Theme-topic Index contains a section entitled "Administration: general". This heading lists those letters of which the import is unclear, generally because reference is made to other correspondence not within Cons 488/31.
